## **Designer Snapshot**

With a home office as inviting as this one, work—or daydreaming at our desk, if we're being honest with ourselves—becomes a pleasure. The late Charline Leith, designer and owner of this traditional 1940s home in Vancouver, transformed an otherwise unused second-floor storage room into a cozy haven for creativity. The eclectic mix of pattern and shape was inspired by Leith's time in the London fashion industry: a vintage walnut desk plays against a modernist tulip seat; plentiful curves (found in
